Blooming of Beloit:

As September approaches, so is the heat and we are chasing the products to harvest on time. Most of the summer flowers are gone and we are at the very end of our Pee Gee Lime Hydrangea.

During September we plan to harvest the following ornamental berries:

- Late variety Viburnum (purple) Dentatum
- Bittersweet (American & Oriental)
*Please be aware that we ship out our bittersweet in its most advanced stage of maturity. As you receive the product and notice the yellow leaves, please note that this is the best condition for the capsule to open and receive the most vibrant color fruit.
- Three categories of Rose hips:
 - Luci, Debra & Fantasy
- Seed Pod Lace Hydrangea
- Three categories of Malus (crabapple)

Israel Line:

The current weather conditions in Israel in addition to hot weather here in the states has forced us to make changes in our Lisianthus packaging in order to assure quality. We urge our customers to make an extra effort, by collecting your product from the airport as soon as possible upon arrival and avoid leaving the product by the airlines regardless of their guarantee to store it in the cooler. In the last two weeks we have experienced quality issues when the Lisianshus was not unpacked in a decent timeframe.

We are now offering Blooming Grevillea, Asclepias Tuberosa and Biatrux, Green Bell, Celosia & both

- Adams, Red Sentinel & Red Jewel
- Pink Euonymus (hot pink cascade, Euonymus Europaeus)



Following the above line of products, we hope to start harvesting within two weeks:

- Orange Ilex
- Red Berry Aronia

Our last line of berries to be harvested is the Red Winterberry (Ilex Verticillata). We hope for it to be ready between 4-6 weeks from now.

Between the rain fall, drip irrigation and the extremely pleasant temperatures, our twigs production reached a record level of quality and quantity, and will be ready to start shipping from the farm approximately 10-14 days after the 'killer frost'.

Crocoma – pink & café.

The greenery list remains the same:

- Ruscus, Mini Variegated Pittosprum, Variegated Pittosporum , Kochia, Ivy, Gold Grevillea, Aralia, Aspidistra , Monstera, Xanadu.

We continue with our summer plan of two shipments per week to New York, landing Monday night for Tuesday delivery (order Thursday) and Thursday night landing for Friday delivery (order by Monday)

Due to the extensive orders and relatively large quantities we might extend our weekly shipping days from 3 to 5 days, in order to fulfill the demand. We also offer daily service from the farm with Fedex, UPS & Speedee. Pick-up at the farm is available 7/24.
